We support novel solutions for risk-sharing through pilot grants.

We capture and synthesize evidence from our grants on equitable risk-sharing.

We convene a global group of humanitarian actors, to define agendas that incorporate local and regional priorities.

We model equitable capacity-sharing throughout our programme, and capture learning on equitable capacity-sharing to share with the humanitarian system.
